



## 2017 GRADES 6-12 SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Richmond County Summer School awards credit to students in grades 6-12 in accordance with the standards set by AdvancED in order to provide a pathway to promotion and/or graduation. Information and registration forms are provided to assist you in applying for summer school. If additional information is required, you may contact your child's school.

**Registration Time:** Pre-Registration is **March 23 – March 31** and will be conducted at each school. Magnet school students will register at their magnet school, but will attend summer school at their home (zoned) schools. All questions concerning summer school and the registration process should be directed to your child's home school.

**Tuition/Fees:** Richmond County School System students: **\$250.00** per course/session  
Non-Richmond County School System students: **\$300.00** per course/session  
New Work for RCSS students (2 sessions): **\$500**  
Late Registration Fee: **\$25.00**

**NOTE:** *Late registration is contingent upon course availability.*

**Only money orders or cashier's checks** made payable to Richmond County Board of Education will be accepted for payment of tuition and should be paid at the home school. Online payments will be available at a later date. Prepayment is also accepted at the **Richmond County Board of Education Building at 864 Broad Street Augusta, GA 30901** between the hours of **8:00am-5:00pm**.

**Tuition Assistance & Payment Plans:** Tuition waivers are designated to Title I middle and high Schools for Math, Science, Social Studies and English courses only. There are limited Title I funds for tuition assistance. Registration is integral to determining the allocation of tuition assistance vouchers.

Payment plan information will be sent at a later date. Credit card and ACH payments will also be available online. However, the full balance for summer courses is due on or prior to **Wednesday, July 12, 2017**.

**Maximum Course Load:** 2 courses/sessions

**Summer School Dates/Times:** MONDAY – THURSDAY 8:00 a.m. – 1:15 p.m.

**Classes begin:** Monday, June 5, 2017 **Classes end:** Thursday, July 13, 2017 **Holiday:** Monday, July 4, 2017

**Class schedule:** 1<sup>st</sup> Period - 8:00 a.m. - 10:30 a.m. 2<sup>nd</sup> Period - 10:45a.m. - 1:15 p.m.

**Attendance/Tardies:** The maximum number of days a student can be absent during summer school is *three*, including days off roll. Students who are tardy for more than one cumulative hour and students with unexcused absences will be considered as "cutting" school and will be dropped from classes with no refund of fees. Medical appointments, as well as vacations, should be scheduled for days/times that do not conflict with summer school hours.

**Transportation & Nutrition:** Transportation is available for all summer schools. The School Nutrition Department provides the Summer Nutrition Program (SNP) free of charge to all students with the serving times of 7:30am (breakfast) and 11:30 am (lunch).

**Refund Policy:** Students who withdraw from summer school will be reimbursed according to the following schedule:

Before the beginning of the:	2 <sup>nd</sup> Day (Tuesday, June 6, 2017) - 80%	4 <sup>th</sup> Day (Thursday, June 8, 2016) - 40%
	3 <sup>rd</sup> Day (Wednesday, June 7, 2017) - 60%	5 <sup>th</sup> Day (Monday, June 12, 2016) - 20%

**No refunds will be issued after the start of classes on Tuesday, June 13, 2017.**
