- Official high school transcript (must accompany the application)
- Provide two signed, letters of recommendation from a high school teacher and a community professional that can attest to your community service/volunteer efforts.
- Complete the scholarship application form and return by March 25, 2016
- Submit a typed essay of no less than 700 words on the topic: 'What African American woman is your Shero and what traits, if any, do you share with your Shero?"
- Time Frame: January 3rd through March 25th in the year of 2016

What African American woman is your Shero and what traits, if any, do you

share with your Shero? Explanation of Shero: Hero is defined as "a remarkably brave person: someone who commits an act of remarkable bravery or who has shown an admirable quality such as great courage or strength of character; and/or somebody admired: somebody who is admired for outstanding qualities or achievements". A Shero is held to the same definition, but instead of a male, the brave and admired person is female. The Sister's Only Club (SOC) takes the definition of Shero a little further and defines the term as ordinary women doing extraordinary things (i.e. mentoring, volunteering, and establishing non-profits) in their communities.
