School and Community

Our school was opened in 1969 with eleven classrooms in one building. In the 1970's, fifteen classrooms were added in two additional wings. In 1998, a much needed Physical Education building was added to our campus. Although Glenn Hills serves a diverse population, and for many years was the hub for ESOL students in Richmond County, the majority of our students are African American. Our school is home to the Gators, and our school colors are green and white. We are a community school, and feed into Glenn Hills Middle and High Schools. Glenn Hills Elementary School is located on the highest hill in Augusta near the intersection of Bobby Jones Expressway and Deans Bridge Road. We are in the vicinity of Augusta Technical College.

General Information

Glenn Hills Elementary offers extensive opportunities for its Pre-K to Grade 5 population. The Administration, Highly Qualified Teachers, and Staff work together to provide a unified curriculum that consists of challenging and diverse programs with emphasis on meeting the needs of the individual student. GHES follows the RCSS Common CORE curriculum, which is very rigorous and designed to prepare our students to be college and career ready. Our students are assessed three times a year using the IReady program, which is tailored for each individual student, and using Vport DIBELS. Grades K-3 are also participating in the Georgia Office of School and Accountability Mentor Reading Grant. GHES offers a variety of club opportunities for students to participate in as follows: Student Council, Beta, Ambassador, Science, Math, Women of the Future, Young G.E.N.T.S., Drama and Safety Patrol.

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in three main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
