School and Community

Glenn Hills High School serves a multicultural community in South Richmond County. Glenn Hills High School promotes high academic standards through strategic implementation of the curriculum set forth by the Georgia Department of Education and the expectations of the Richmond County School System. Glenn Hills has a rich tradition of community leaders and distinguished alumni to include former School Superintendents, State Senators, State Representatives, judges, lawyers, doctors, professional athletes and educators.

Glenn Hills High is located in Augusta, Georgia which is the second largest and oldest city in Georgia. Augusta is best known as the Garden City and home of the Masters Golf Tournament. RCSS operates 58 schools and serves over 30,000 students. RCSS has an International Baccalaureate Program, top-rated magnet schools and programs, specialized curricula such as STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) and arts infusion, and technology rich classrooms.

Class Rank and Grade Point Average

An official class rank is compiled for each grade that is computed at the end of the year. Averages are carried out to three decimal places and final averages are not rounded. Grades for the class of 2016 and 2017 are unweighted. Student's grade point average (GPA) will be based on quality points beginning with the graduating class of 2018. Regular high school courses will be on a 4.0 scale and AP, IB and College/University Courses on a 5.0 scale awarded for each grade earned. High school student transcripts include the GPA, class rank and numerical average.

General Information

Glenn Hills High offers a strong curriculum with more than 100 possible course selections with electives and pathways available in CTAE, JROTC, drama, music, journalism, automotive shop, cosmetology, and advance placement classes. Comprehensive services are available for special education students and students with special needs.

Programs of study include Cosmetology, Early Childhood Education, Industry Certification & Computer Science Program, Introduction to Sports Management, Marketing, Web Design, and Georgia BEST (Business Ethics Student Training). In addition, GHHS hosts Move on When Ready (Dual Enrollment) In-house Program with Augusta Technical College as well as a Cohort Monitoring Program.

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in three main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
