School and Community

Goshen Elementary School is located 12 miles from downtown Augusta in the southeastern part of Richmond County, Georgia. It opened its doors for the first time during the 1993-1994 school year. The nearest high school is Cross Creek High School at 1.6 miles away, and the nearest middle school is Pine Hill Middle School, which is 2.3 miles away. The district's student population of 35, 236 students has grown by 7% over the last five years. As of November 2016, Goshen's current student enrollment is 526 students and 68 faculty and staff members. Goshen is operated by RCSS which has 58 schools and serves over 30,000 students. RCSS has an International Baccalaureate Program, top-rated magnet schools and programs, specialized curricula such as STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics), Arts infusion, and technology rich classrooms.

General Information

Goshen, in 2015, has partnered with ArtsNow, a nonprofit organization dedicated to transforming education by equipping teachers with professional development. ArtsNow integrates the arts into daily classroom instruction and allows all students to succeed academically, socially, and artistically. Goshen Elementary has an outdoor classroom science lab, greenhouse, and fish pond for hands-on discovery labs. Elite 8 Vertical Feeder Collaboration is hosted by Cross Creek High School, where all 8 feeder schools in our area meet for Parent University sessions on various educational topics. "Dragon Tails" School-Wide Behavioral Incentives provides for a variety of special character building activities. Goshen Elementary is the first and only STEAM School in Richmond County.

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in three main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
