School and Community

Langford World Middle School was named for Rupert Langford, the chairman of the Richmond County Board of Education in the 1940s who died at age 41 in September 1950. Langford was Augusta's first junior high school. Langford World Middle School is located in Augusta which is the second largest and oldest city in Georgia. Augusta is best known as the Garden City and home of the Masters Golf Tournament. Since the early 1980s, Langford has been a middle school housing sixth, seventh, and eighth graders.

General Information

Langford World Middle School became a certified International Baccalaureate school in 2014. It is the goal of Langford World Middle School to develop inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect. Langford's students receive daily instruction that combines the rigorous IB standards with the Georgia Performance Standards. Students are encouraged to make connections with the world around them while mastering the state adopted content standards in the core content areas of English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Arts, and Technology. Langford World Middle School also offers high school courses such as Coordinate Algebra, Physical Science, American Government, and Spanish I.

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in three main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
