General Information

Monte Sano strives to promote each student with a high-quality education using the RCK12 Curriculum (Rigorous Curriculum and Knowledge through 12). It is our belief that our teachers will prepare each student for success by using the consistent instructional framework provided by our county. A past recipient of the Georgia Innovative School of Excellence Grant, Monte Sano continues to meet yearly adequate progress. An enthusiastic staff serves the children of the community with a variety of instructional programs and clubs.

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in three main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
