General Information

Academically, we are proud to Offer Advanced Courses to accelerate high school credit accumulation. Students can earn Carnegie Units in Algebra I, Physical Science, and Spanish. We offer a wide variety of sports including football, basketball, softball, baseball, track, golf, and cheerleading. At MRMS we encourage the spirit of competition and aim to strive for greatness by offering clubs and extracurricular activities such as National Junior Beta Club; Student Council, No Place for Hate, Principal's Book Club; Karisma/Classy Pearls girl mentoring groups and School Nutrition, all to help our students become well rounded and productive citizens. Our Future Business Leaders of America (FBLA) participate in the annual Regional Leadership conferences. College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in three main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
