## School and Community

Southside Elementary is located in South Augusta. This Title One School serves over 400 students from Pre-Kindergarten to Fifth grade. Our school population consists of African American, Caucasian, Hispanic and Multi-racial students. We are a small neighborhood school that takes pride in our family engagement and community partners to include Golden Harvest, Starbucks, FFLC, and Chancey's Wrecker Service. Our active school council and PTA allow parents and community to serve as stakeholders and be included in decisions that affect our school.

## General Information

Southside teaches the K- 5th Georgia Standards of Excellence. Teachers follow the RCK12 Instructional Framework which provides rigorous instruction for all students to include general education as well as special education. Modified instruction and services are provided for gifted, ESOL and students with disabilities. We are implementing the AVID curriculum which provides students with instructional strategies and activities to prepare them to be college and career ready. Our students are prepared for leadership and recognized for academic excellence by participating in Student Council, Beta Club and AVID Ambassadors.

## College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in three main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
