We are writing to share with you that Cross Creek High School will be testing students online during our upcoming winter administration of the Georgia Milestones End-of-Course (EOC) administration. The information below is provided to assist you and your student in becoming familiar with the features of online testing.

- A website, called Experience Online Testing Georgia, has been established to provide an
  opportunity for students to become familiar with the online testing platform. The website can
  be found at the link that follows http://www.gaexperienceonline.com/.
- This practice site is intended to allow students to familiarize themselves with the online platform prior to testing.

## Please review the following policies with your student before testing:

- Electronic Devices—Students are not permitted to have any electronic devices, including but not limited to cell phones, smartphones, and smartwatches, at any time during testing OR during breaks (e.g., restroom), even if they are turned off or students do not use them. If your student is found with an electronic device, his or her test will be invalidated.
- Devices are not allowed in the testing environment and that possession or improper use of such
  devices during testing may result in disciplinary action in accordance with the system's student
  code of conduct and/or test invalidation.
