WHAT

A program that gives students an opportunity to work with certified teachers on school assignments, work on social emotional health, and acquire skills to restoratively resolve conflicts. Students who attend the program participate in group counseling provided by CSRA Family Counseling Center. Transportation is provided through the Alternative School Hub Stations.

WHO

Middle and High School students who are suspended from school for ten or less days and are not pending tribunal.

The P.A.S.S Program connects wraparound services, academic counseling, and restorative practices with traditional discipline to decrease recidivism and increase academic success

P.A.S.S. Program Hours

MONDAY-THURSDAY

9:30 am - 5:30 pm

Breakfast, lunch and afternoon snack provided.

HOW

STEP 1: School receives oral permission from parent/guardian for student to participate.

STEP 2: Once the school receives parental permission they must call the Success Center at (706) 826-1310 x 4989.

STEP 3: School gives student parental Consent to Participate Form and Consent for Counseling Form.

STEP 4: Students in need of transportation are advised about Hub schedule by home school personnel.

STEP 5: Student brings both signed consent forms on following day to Success Center at Morgan Rd for admission to program.
