Teacher Wide Middle School Policies

Late Work Policies

All work is expected to be turned in ON TIME. But in the event of late work, this is the policy we follow.

- → Classwork Due at the END OF CLASS. Anything not turned in will result in a M (missing) flag and a permanent 0 grade. If teacher gives additional time outside of class to finish work, it then turns into homework.
 - o Teachers will follow all IEP & 504 Accommodations
- → Homework/Projects 10 points will be deducted daily if the assignment is not turned in. After <u>three</u> <u>consecutive school days</u> a 0 grade will be inputted in the grade book.

- → **Communication** If you currently do not have access to Infinite Campus please go ahead and obtain it. The main way we communicate grades is through that channel. Current grade emails, sent through Infinite Campus, will be sent every other Friday afternoon (twice a month). If you have any questions about assignment grades, please contact the teacher. Please make sure that you have an updated email on file to receive those messages. We recommend parents turn on alerts so that you receive instant information as grades/assignments are posted.

Cellphone Policy for 6th and 7th grade

- → **No Phones** Cellphones should not be visible in the classroom or hallways. Phones should stay in students' book bags or lockers. The ONLY time they are allowed to have them is during lunch.
 - Not in their pockets
 - Not in their lap
 - Cellphones should not be visible!!
- → **Consequences** Teachers will immediately take up phones, take them to the office, contact parents (email, Remind or phone call) and students will be written up. Parents must then come to the school and retrieve the device.
- \rightarrow 8th Grade students will be allowed to have phones and should follow each teacher's specific cellphone policy

Behavior Expectations

- → For any tentative reward events, field trips, celebrations or special events students must meet certain requirements academically and behaviorally in order to participate.
 - PAWtastic Celebrations & Field Trips
 - 80 average in all classes
 - No more than 3 absences during that month
 - No tardies
 - No discipline (AFD, ISS, ISD, OSS)
 - Special Events
 - 70 average in all classes
 - No discipline (AFD, ISS, ISD, OSS)
 - Present on the day of the event
