Belair K-8 was established in 2018. Since then, our school has grown our students through academic and social engagement. Students who attend Belair K-8 reside near our school and live within the Richmond County School District. Students within our school zone have previously attended Sue Reynolds Elementary School and Langford Middle School.

- Our school features a solar farm comprised of over one thousand tempered glass panels that allow our school to be fully sustainable on a
 cool, sunny day. This also gives our students and the surrounding community first-hand exposure to renewable energy technologies and
 sustainability.
- We have 22 STEM certified educators who participated in Cohort One through a partnership with Augusta University. These teachers are at the core of our STE(A)M "Grand Challenge" and are dedicated to providing an education experiences— in an interdisciplinary and applied approach.
- We have Community Partners which include: National Security Agency (NSA), Mastermind Escape Games, Cyber Academy of Excellence, Georgia Architects, and IOTA Communications.
- We offer students educational enrichment opportunities through robotics, coding, architecture, astronomy, virtual reality, art, and music.

Our Points of Pride:

- We are a 1:1 school. Students in Kindergarten through 2nd Grade have iPads for individual use during the instructional day. Students in Grades 3-8 have laptops for individual use during the instructional day and for use at home for school-related work.
- We have THREE STEM Labs and TWO Computer Labs
- We have TWO WiFi-enabled covered Outdoor Learning Pavilions
- We have a Collaborative Learning Room/Makerspace that will easily accommodate two full classes of students
- Middle school sports: Baseball, Basketball (boys' and girls' teams), cheerleading, football, volleyball, golf, and track & field (boys' and girls' teams)
- We offer a "Falcon Time" intervention/acceleration period each day for Grades K-8

Our CCRPI stats:

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in five main categories, for a total of 100 possible points. In 2019-2020, statewide accountability was suspended due to COVID-19 closures.
