Your mandatory sketchbook will be used to create a semester long project that will be graded at the end of the EACH semester.

### **Major Course Projects and Instructional Activities**

Each lesson will begin with an exploration of art or artists, typically in the form of a slideshow but various instructional strategies will be used throughout the semester/year, to introduce and re-explore new concepts, ideas, and materials. Each introduction will be followed by a demonstration of materials and techniques which will then be followed with a project that will allow students to showcase their new knowledge and skills. Projects will typically last one week before a new concept/project will be introduced.

#### **Course Assessment Plan**

Students will receive a variety of assignments designed to enhance their learning and skills during the week or throughout the project. Attached under a link titled 'Student Assessment Rubric' will be a rubric that will be

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used as the primary source for project grades. If a student is absent, the student is responsible for requesting the missed assignment. They will be allowed to turn in any late assignment after the due date with no loss of points (we all sometimes need a little grace and an extension of good faith), but if the assignment is not turned in by the time grades/report cards are due the assignment will be listed as Missing and they will receive a zero for it.

# **Evaluation (Schoolwide Grading Policy)**

- Summative Assessments 30% (Unit & Chapter Test, Projects, Tasks)
- Formative Assessments 60% (Quizzes, Class work, Graded Writing Assignments, Group Work, etc.)
- Homework/Other 10% (assigned at teacher's discretion)
