Major Course Projects and Instructional Activities

Each lesson will begin with an exploration of art or artist. We will use a variety of mediums such as slide shows, videos, and demonstrations to introduce and explore new concepts, revisit old ones, and to learn how to use our materials properly and be able to bring our ideas to life. Projects will be completed to allow students to showcase their new knowledge and skills. Projects will typically last one week before a new concept/project is introduced.

Course Assessment Plan

Students will receive a variety of assignments designed to enhance their learning during their project work time. Attached under a link on my website titled 'Student Assessment Rubric' you will find a rubric that will be used as the primary source for project grades. If a student is absent, the student is responsible for requesting the missed assignment or make up the time lost. They will be allowed to turn in any late assignment after the due date with no loss of points (we all sometimes need a little grace and an extension of good father), but if the assignment is not turned in by the time grades/report cards are due the assignment will be listed as missing and they will receive a zero for it.

- Summative Assessments 30% (Unit & Chapter Test, Projects, Tasks)
- Formative Assessments 60% (Quizzes, Class work, Graded Writing Assignments, Group Work, etc.)
- Homework/Other 10% (assigned at teacher's discretion)

Classroom Procedures & Expectations
