

Science Fair Submission Guidelines:

1. Science Fair project **MUST** be done on a tri-board (*no powepoints*). This goes for face-to-face students and for online students. This is because the regional science fair requires for projects to be on boards. If you are chosen to go to regionals, then your project will already be on a board.
2. Online students will record a video of themselves presenting their tri-board. They will submit this video on CANVAS. It will only be seen by me. In the video, speak as though you are presenting to the class. You will need to tell me all about your project. Make sure your tri-board is seen FULLY on camera. Tell me what your question, hypothesis, materials, procedure, results, and conclusion was. I do not mind if you read straight from your board. If you have put in the work to do a good project, then reading from the board will give me all of the information I need to know in order to grade you. Remember, this is still a class assignment even though you are home, so please speak eloquently.
3. THE DUE DATE FOR TURNING IN YOUR SCIENCE FAIR PROJECT (WHETHER ONLINE OR FACE TO FACE) IS **MONDAY, OCTOBER 5TH**. This gives anyone who had any technical difficulties over the summer some extra time to get everything together.
4. Everyone **MUST** turn in a project. If you haven't started, please do so ASAP.
