

# 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Classroom Management Plan

## 2019-2020

The purpose of classroom management is to keep a stable and positive learning environment at all times. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated at Monte Sano Elementary School. In our fourth grade classrooms, we will use the *Strike System*. Each Monday your child starts the week off with 100 points. If your child has been given a warning to correct their behavior and continues to display that behavior, he/she will receive a *strike* and 5 points will be deducted from their conduct grade.

In order for students to begin the school year knowing what is expected of them, we are including a list of classroom expectations. Please read and discuss the importance of following them with your child. Conduct reports will be sent home daily. Please review the report, initial nightly, and return to school the following day.

\*LISTEN CAREFULLY AND FOLLLOW DIRECTIONS FIRST TIME GIVEN

\*RAISE YOUR HAND TO SPEAK OR GET OUT OF YOUR SEAT

\*KEEP YOUR HANDS AND FEET TO YOURSELF AT ALL TIMES

\*COME TO CLASS PREPARED WITH ALL SUPPLIES AND COMPLETED HOMEWORK

\*DO NOT BRING INAPPROPRIATE ITEMS TO CLASS; INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO GUM, CANDY, TOYS, ETC...
