Instructional Strategy of the Week:

5E's - EXPLORE

The exploration phase provides the opportunity for students to become directly involved with the key concepts of the lesson through guided exploration that requires them to probe, inquire, and question.

These activities give students time to think, plan, manipulate, investigate, and organize collected information.

Think of explore as allowing time for students to: **EXPERIENCE LEARNING**

- > encourage investigation and inquiry
- > hands-on tasks
