## **Discipline Policy/Plan**

A conduct sheet is maintained by the teacher. Students receive tally marks for conduct infractions. Students have received warnings prior to receiving tally marks/first offense.

Each tally results in walking 5 laps at recess.

### **Discipline Plan is as follows:**

First Offense- (95)- Student receives 1 tally mark. Counsel student.

Second Offense (90) - Student receives tally mark

Third Offense (85) – Student receives tally mark

Fourth Offense (80)- Student receives tally mark. Parent is contacted via email or note. MIR report is sent home.

Five offenses in one day constitutes a discipline referral.

Any office referral (fighting, swearing, bullying, etc.) results in 20 point conduct deduction.
