### Discipline Policy/Plan

A conduct sheet is maintained by the teacher. Students receive tally marks for conduct infractions. Students have received warnings prior to receiving tally marks/first offense.

***Each tally results in walking 5 laps at recess.***

#### Discipline Plan is as follows:

First Offense– (95)- Student receives 1 tally mark. Counsel student.

Second Offense (90)– Student receives tally mark

Third Offense (85)– Student receives tally mark

Fourth Offense (80)- Student receives tally mark. Parent is contacted via email or note. MIR report is sent home.

Five offenses in one day constitutes a discipline referral.

**Any office referral (fighting, swearing, bullying, etc.) results in 20 point conduct deduction.**
