Last week, the Richmond County School District made the decision to delay the start of face-to-face instruction due to the increase in COVID-19 related cases. As a result, I have compiled the following details for guidance purposes as we begin the second semester of school.

- Online Instruction: All Online students will begin instruction as scheduled on Tuesday, January 12th. Teachers are reaching out to connect with you for instruction. Class links for K, 1st, 5th, 6th and 8th can be found on the Belair Website and class links for 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 7th, will be found on the Richmond Hill webpage as they are assisting us with the facilitation of teacher instruction.
- Learn @Home Instruction: Learn@Home instruction for all face-to-face students will begin this Thursday, January 14th. Learning packets and report cards can be picked up on Mon. Wed. of this week between the hours of 9 am 11 am and 2 pm and 4 pm. K-2 pickup bus area, 3 -5 pick up front circle and 6-8 pickup car line. The tentative day of return to Belair for all F2F students is Tuesday, January 26th.
- **FEV Tutoring:** Please have your child take advantage of FEV Tutoring. Each student has access to this <u>free</u> tutoring 24/7. The link to this opportunity is on the Belair webpage.
- Meals: The Belair School Nutrition Staff will be distributing meals each Tuesday and Friday from 9 am to 1 pm in the back of the cafeteria.
