Class Description:

This class will help you build confidence in your reading, writing, listening, and speaking skills in the Spanish language. You will be able to have conversations, present information to others, and understand written and spoken language on a variety of topics. Lessons will be built around thematic units in order to make the material more meaningful and memorable. It will also give the opportunity to study some of the differences and similarities between American and Hispanic cultures. Students will use *Realidades* book and workbook for each class.
