

GA Pandemic EBT (P-EBT)

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



What is P-EBT?

A program that gives families with schoolchildren eligible for the free or reduced school meals program an EBT card to purchase food when schools are operating virtual learning or hybrid schedules due to Covid-19.



Is My Household Eligible for P-EBT?

Your household is eligible if your child would receive free or reduced-price school meals if schools were operating normally. This includes any student in a school that provides free meals to all students through Community Eligibility Program (CEP) and if your child is attending school virtually or has a hybrid schedule.



How is eligibility determined?

Please contact your child's school regarding eligibility status for the 2020-2021 school term.
