HOW IT WORKS:

Virtual Learning



If your child(ren) attends school virtually, they may be eligible to receive P-EBT benefits for school year 2020-2021.

Hybrid Learning



If your child(ren) attends school virtually some days and in person other days, they may be eligible to receive P-EBT benefits for the days they are attending virtually.



NEW! Children under the age of six (6) in SNAP households are eligible for P-EBT benefits if they live in or attended childcare in an area where one or more schools or childcare facilities are closed or operating with reduced attendance or hours – for the months they received SNAP.



WHAT YOU'LL GET:

Households will receive a P-EBT card with the value of benefits. If you already have a SNAP EBT card, P-EBT funds will be added to it.
