


Reopening Update

Richmond County COVID-19 Numbers

- As of 3 August 2020 at 3:00 p.m. (14 July Numbers)
 - Confirmed Cases: 3786 (1830)
 - Number of Richmond County Residents: 202,518
 - Cases per Week Moving Average: 883 (250)
 - Cases per 100k Richmond County Residents: 1872(905)
 - Deaths per 100k Richmond County Residents: 42 (31)
 - Total Deaths: 83(62)

- Anticipated and Planned for approximately one-third (Online)
- Total student enrollment 30,000 plus
- Over ½ or 16,000 plus Parents selected Online Learning
- Pivot to school-based Online Services/Instruction
