Class Rotations

This year in third grade, your child will have three teachers. Ms. Murphy will be teaching Reading. Mrs. McGhee will be teaching Mathematics. Miss Welmaker will be teaching Science and Social Studies.

Class Rules and Expectations

1. Students must be respectful at ALL times.
2. Students must keep ALL of their personal belongings (i.e. hands, feet, and other items) to themselves.
3. Students must raise their hand for permission to speak and to get up from their seat.
4. Students must follow ALL directions when they are given.
5. Students must come to class EVERYDAY with all necessary materials to learn.

Homework Policy

Homework is an extension to the instruction that your child received during the school day. I am asking that your child completes their homework when it is assigned. If your child does not complete their homework, it will negatively impact their grades.

Behavior/Conduct Policy

I use a positive behavior plan in the classroom. In the event that I have to provide consequences, I will use the following steps:

1. Verbal warning
2. Silent lunch/ walk at recess (5minutes)
3. Walk at recess (entire time)
4. Call to parent and time out in another classroom
5. Parent Conference
6. Office referral
