Course Description:

<u>Math</u>: Students will demonstrate knowledge of counting, number sense, shapes, measurement, investigating and addition/subtraction.

<u>ELA/Writing</u>: Students will demonstrate knowledge of writing, print concepts, phonological awareness, phonics and word recognition.

<u>Science/Health</u>: Students will demonstrate knowledge of the world around them using their senses to make observations about matter, gravity, day/night, living/nonliving things, animals, plants, rocks and soils. Students will also learn the importance of health/safety.

<u>Social Studies</u>: Students will demonstrate knowledge in themes that focus on culture, individuals, groups, locations, scarcity, time, change, and continuity.

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS:

I use the Class Dojo point system in my classroom to monitor classroom expectations. Students will earn positive points for situations such as teamwork, being on task, homework, and having a positive attitude. Students may lose points for being off task, disrespectful/rude behavior, talking out, or no homework. I will send home invitations for Class Dojo access so that you can monitor your child's class behavior. Daily behavior reports will be included on the homework calendar, LMF will have a school wide behavior policy: PBIS- Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports. The entire school will be focused on being safe, being responsible, and being respectful at all times!
