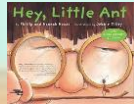
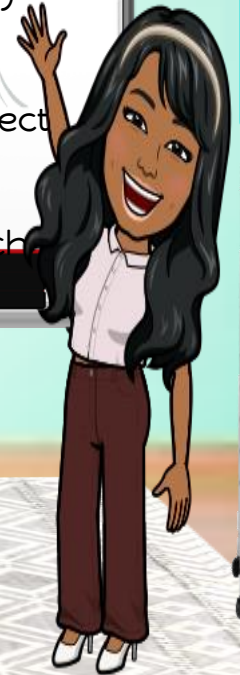


- Use a capital letter at the beginning of my sentence.
