## As a Parent, HOW can I help?

- Review schedule in Infinite Campus Parent Portal
- Practice logging into Canvas through Launch Pad
- Encourage your child to take frequent breaks, exercise regularly, and establish healthy eating habits
- Download Canvas student and parent app
- Monitor your child's growth in Canvas

## **BEFORE** the First Day of School

- Go back-to-school shopping with your teacher's supply list
- Attend the Open House
- Log onto your computer
- Log into Launchpad \*
- Locate and explore the Canvas App
- Complete the <u>Learning with Canvas</u>
  Orientation
- Install the Microsoft Suite (found in the Microsoft 365 app in Launch Pad)
- Expect your teacher to contact you
- Explore your teacher's webpage. Make sure you know your assigned synchronous lesson time & day
- \* If you need assistance with logging In (Username and Password) Contact Guidance

Before September 8<sup>th</sup>, we recommend that students and parents complete the Canvas Orientations found at <a href="rcboe.org/canvas">rcboe.org/canvas</a>. We recommend that students send their teachers a practice message inside Canvas just to let the teacher know the student is ready for September 8<sup>th</sup>. The orientations will give students and parents a high-level introduction to the features Canvas offers. The Communications department has shared orientation resources on the rcboe.org homepage and on social media. Those orientations can be found on the <a href="rcboe.org/canvas">rcboe.org/canvas</a> webpage.

Parents are able to connect to their students' accounts by "pairing." This is something that parents will have to do, there is no automated process. In addition to the resources on our website, we wanted to provide you with the steps.


1. Parents are recommended to download the Canvas Parent app since most engage with Canvas from their phones. This will also allow them to receive notifications on their phones. It is free.



2. The student will log into his/her Canvas account through Launch Pad. Once in Canvas, they will click on their account (circle with silhouette or photo) and click **QR for Mobile Login.** This will generate a QR code that is valid for 10 minutes. The parent can scan the QR code from their Canvas Parent app. This will take the parent directly to the student's page.



3. Next, the parent will be asked for the student's pairing code. From the student's account, the student will select Settings (see image above). In the Settings, there will be a button on the right side of the page called **Pair with Observer**. When the user presses this button, it will generate a short pairing code. The parent will enter this code in the app. The parent only has to do this process once for the child's educational career (K-12).



- 4. That's it. The parent and student are now paired. They can repeat the same steps with pairing codes to add additional children if needed.
