### **GUIDANCE FROM HEALTH OFFICIALS**

RCSS will continue to adhere to the most recent COVID guidelines issued by the Georgia Department of Public Health (GADPH) and the Center for Disease Control (CDC).

### **ROBUST SAFETY PROTOCOLS**

Robust safety protocols are in place at school campuses and RCSS facilities, including needed personal protective equipment, frequent disinfecting, and hand washing.

### **ADDITIONAL SUPPORT**

Increased staffing to effectively clean and disinfect schools.

### **HYGIENE**

Restrooms and handwashing sinks in classrooms are stocked with soap and paper towels. Hand sanitizer stations are available in locations throughout all school campuses.

### **VACCINATIONS**

RCSS encourages students ages 12 and older, staff and family members to receive vaccinations through GADPH, AU Health, or the Federal Retail Pharmacy Program.
