Our Story:

Jenkins-White Elementary School (JWES) is an accredited inner-city school located on the industrial outskirts of Augusta, Richmond County, Georgia. It is located on 15th Avenue near the Medical College of Georgia and Paine College. Enrollment data reveals that JWES serves a low socio-economic student population compared to both the district and the state. JWES has a student population of approximately 375 students pre-kindergarten to fifth grade that are supported by 63 faculty and staff member.

Our CCRPI stats:

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in five main categories, for a total of 100 possible points. In 2017-2018 CCRPI was redesigned so that scores in 2018 and 2019 are not comparable to previous years. Jenkins-White Elementary School was closed in the 2018-2019 school year and reopened in 2020-2021. Therefore, Jenkins-White Elementary School does not have current CCRPI scores. In 2019-2020, statewide accountability was suspended due to COVID-19 closures.
