Program Description: The purpose of the Summer Enrichment Program is to allow students to experience learning in a fun, creative, hands-on manner. Using higher-level thinking and project-based instruction, students will work collaboratively to complete and present culminating tasks that challenge the mind and energize the spirit.

Academics: The Summer Program is not grades-based, and the Georgia Milestones will not be administered this summer. I-Ready will be used to boost students' reading and math skills.



Discipline Policy: The discipline policy of the Richmond County School System will be obeyed. **Positive Behavior Intervention Strategies** (PBIS) will be followed. Students will be allowed a maximum of three reflection periods during the Summer Enrichment Program. Pine Hill is a **No Bullying Zone!**

Dress Code: The Richmond County School System and Pine Hill Middle School Dress Codes must be followed. There should be no hats, hoods, or Air Pods in the building. Cell phones are allowed but should not visible, used, or displayed during the instructional day.

Attendance: Monday – Thursday, 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM. Car riders must be picked up by 1:15 daily. Students must have regular attendance to receive credit for attending the Summer Program.

Meals: Breakfast and lunch served daily. Pick-up meals are available for online students and may be picked up at the rear of the cafeteria.



Safety Protocols: Masks are required at all times at school and on buses. Hand washing and sanitizing are required, and students should practice social distancing when possible. Students must **bring their own water bottles**, as there are only bottle-filling stations available in the school.

Transportation: Transportation is available during the Summer Enrichment Program for preregistered face-to-face students. Car riders should enter and exit through the car-rider zone near the gym. The front of the school is for buses only until 9:15 AM.
