What is an accepted Proof of Residency?

One of the following with the name and address of the enrolling parent/guardian: (Documentation must be dated within 30 days of the enrollment date.)

Current Lease/rental agreement Most recent income tax return Current paycheck stub Current Medicaid card Current residential property tax statement or bill Current warranty or quick claim deed Current home purchase agreement Current homeowners's insurance policy Current utility bill (Water, Gas, or Electric) We can NOT accept cable or cell phone bill

If the student's family is residing in the home or apartment of another individual, the person with whom the family is living and whose name matches the proof of residence must present these documents for enrollment:

Notarized third-person affidavit of residency Photo ID of person with whom the family is residing Proof of Residency matching the name and address of person with whom the family is residing Inclusion of person with whom the family is residing as a contact on the registration form

What is NOT an accepted Proof of Residency?

Cell Phone Bill

Bank Statement (or any other communication from a financial institution)

Credit Card Bill

Medical Bill

Cable Bill

Car Tag Receipt/Bill

Insurance Statement (Car, Medical, Life, Home)

Unsolicited Mail
