- Students should complete their digital citizenship curriculum with their homeroom teachers.
- Each student's parent/guardian must complete the parent orientation by attending the live presentation or by viewing the recorded presentation under the Parent Tab/1:1 Devices on the A.R. Johnson Website.
- Each student's parent/guardian must complete the parent orientation survey link that will accompany the parent orientation presentation.
- Each student and parent/guardian should read the PowerUp 1:1 Handbook and return a signed copy of their RCSS Student Technology Loan Agreement form to their HR teacher.
