Students will share a similar starting point in every class. As the class progresses, each student has the opportunity to expand the assignment to a larger endeavor.

General Expectations

- Use constructive language, remain kind, and seek understanding.
- Ensure your behavior does not disrupt the productivity of the class.

ARC Art Class Expectations

- Have your **sketchbook** (*provided beginning of the third week*) and a couple of **pencils** in class each day.
- If you have to bring your backpack to class, store it in the designated **Bag Room** as you enter the class.
- We will spend **40 minutes** in instruction time, making/talking-about/thinking-about/critiquing art, everyday.

Grading

The grades in Art will be posted in Infinite Campus as MARKS, 1-6. This general rubric (available on the ARC Art class webpage) is based on proficiency and correlates to percentage grades and the 4.0 scale.

minor Grades [m_] : Exercises, ideation, sketches, reflections

MAJOR Grades [J_] : Projects, application of learned skills, "big" pieces

- Assignments are graded the evening of the first day of class for the week. This is usually on Mondays, and posted by the following morning.
- Missing Assignments/Late Work: **5% off per day late**, with a maximum of 25% off. Submit artwork to the teacher so the submission date can be documented. Assignments more than a week late will not be accepted.
- Each submitted art assignment will be assessed for:
 - **Composition**: Utilizing the Elements of Art & Principles of Design
 - **Craftsmanship**: Using the materials to efficiently present your art.
 - **Authenticity**: YOUR way of creating art.

Tutoring

Tutoring is available after school on **Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday** until 4pm. This is a time for completing missing work, receiving assistance on technique, and discussing individualized curriculum. **Please tell Mr. Lanier during class if you plan to stay for tutoring that day.** No tutoring on Tuesday (come to Art Club.)

A few more things worth knowing...

- We will not be eating during instruction time.
- Drinking water is permitted. Your water container needs to have a **secure** lid. Straws typically do not create a secure lid. Leaking makes for sadness 😞
- The rules for the school are enforced in the Art Rooms.
- The School Board policy on phones/etc. is in effect in the Art Rooms.
