

Joining Your Grade Level/Course Professional Learning Community and Connecting with your Virtual Specialist

What is the Virtual Specialist?

The Virtual Specialist is an instructional mentor, specific to a grade level or course. The Specialist will hold a monthly webinar on content and instructional topics based on requests from educators, and specific topics highlighted by the GaDOE. Each webinar is recorded, and posted in the online learning platform (edWeb) for educators that could not attend.

Instructions for Joining a Grade Level/Course PLC:

Each group is designed as a Professional Learning Community for educators in each grade level and course. The goal of the Virtual Specialist is to provide a place for Georgia Educators to network with each other, share resources, successes and troubleshoot obstacles. To join the Professional Learning Community specific to your needs, follow the steps below.

- Join edWeb, at a free online community for educators USING YOUR SCHOOL/DISTRICT/RESA/DOE EMAIL ADDRESS edweb.net
- 2. Once you are a member, use the "Find Communities" function to search GaDOE



- 3. Choose the grade level or course Professional Learning Community specific to your needs (e.g., GaDOE 2nd Grade PLC, GaDOE 8th Grade PLC, GaDOE Economics PLC)
- 4. Click the link to Join the Community



5. When requesting permission to join the PLC, <u>include your name and school/district/RESA/DOE</u> <u>email address in the section for a personal message</u>
