# VISION STATEMENT


The Richmond County School System will provide an equitable education for all students to prepare them for life beyond the classroom.

Building a globally competitive school system that educates the whole child through teaching, learning, collaboration, and innovation.


#### RICHMOND COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM

# Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS)

MTSS is a system or framework that integrates assessment and intervention within a school-wide, multilevel prevention system to maximize student achievement and reduce behavior problems.

Data-Based Decision Making


RtI: Uses data-based decision making to determine students' responses to interventions in place and adjust based on progress toward the trajected goal

Tiers 2 & Tier 3 Interventions






Students receive services at all levels, depending on need.

### **INTERVENTIONS**

- Based on data
- Start at lower skill
- Must be evidence- or research-based
- ANYONE can receive interventions
- Become more intense and individualized as tier increases



ALL STUDENTS
ACADEMIC AND SOCIAL BEHAVIORAL SKILLS

- Interventions are designed to teach and/or provide remediation for skill deficits. They can be delivered by another person (e.g., teacher, tutor) or through a system (e.g., computer programming).
  - Start-Up/Build-Up kits
  - Choral Reading
  - Cover-Copy-Compare
  - Check-In/Check-Out

- Accommodations are changes made to teaching presentation format, student response method, setting, or scheduling. They are designed to provide students with access to information, as well as to create equal opportunity to demonstrate knowledge/skills.
  - Extended time on tasks
  - Small group testing
  - Repeated/paraphrased directions
  - Shortened assignments
  - Preferential seating
