✓ Activity: Uno card game, using the vocabulary about numbers (1-10) and colors. Also, students will learn the vocabulary necessary to play the game completely in Spanish.

#### Vocabulary:

Uno, dos, tres, cuatro, cinco, seis, siete, ocho, nueve, diez, azul, Amarillo, verde, rojo. Also, the vocabulary needed to play the card game as: es tu turno, barajea, tira la carta, cambia el color, coge las cartas, repartee, brinca un jugador, cambia la dirección del juego, reversa, uno fuera.
