Course Description

Spanish 2 provides a crucial review of Spanish 1 themes, continuing to develop students' speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills while also enhancing their cultural understanding. The primary focus of this course is to develop the students' ability to communicate effectively in a variety of situations and for multiple purposes. Students will improve their fluency and expand their vocabulary related to everyday experiences. They will also learn to correctly use the preterit and imperfect tenses to describe situations and past events

Course Objectives

By the end of this course, students will be able to:

- Communicate using the present, past (preterite and imperfect), and future tenses in Spanish.
- Understand and respond to simple spoken and written Spanish on familiar topics.
- Expand vocabulary related to everyday activities, school, travel, shopping, health, and family.
- Write short paragraphs, messages, and dialogues with improved grammar and structure.
- Demonstrate knowledge and appreciation of Hispanic cultures, including customs, traditions, and geography.
- Ask and answer questions, express opinions, and describe events in detail.

Grading Policy

- Minor Grades 60% (Quizzes, daily work, classwork, homework, participation, listening, speaking, reading, writing)
- Major Grades 40% (Unit tests, projects, essays, research, and other culminating assessments)

Retakes & Recovery

- Students may retake major assessments after completing a relearn/reassessment plan.
- Retakes must be completed within 5 school days of grade return.

Late Work

- Late work is accepted for up to 5 days with a 5% deduction per day.
- After 5 days, the assignment earns a zero.

Course Policies

- Warm-ups (Calentamientos): Begin immediately upon entering class.
- Class Participation: Speaking Spanish daily is required. Completing in class assignments.
- **Homework:** Practice Spanish at home daily (vocabulary, speaking, reviewing notes).
- Make-up Work: Students with excused absences have 5 days to complete assignments.
