School-Wide Discipline Plan: Every Day is a New Day!

1. Verbal warning
2. Conference with students
3. Peace Corner
4. Take away student privilege
5. Phone call home parent/guardian
6. Time-out in another team members classroom (15 minutes)
7. Parent conference with teacher
8. Teacher will complete minor referral in Spotlight
9. Teacher will complete counselor referral form
10. Student, with documentation of behavior, will be sent to Behavior Interventionist for a reflection assignment
11. Conference with teacher, administrator, and MTSS facilitator to develop a behavior plan
12. Create a Major referral
13. If student is suspended, a re-entry conference will occur

Below is a motto for students to write as a reminder of daily expectations. The teacher can designate the number of times it should be written. This can be done when students are in time-out in another team members classroom or when a loss of privilege is given.
