- 1. Verbal warning
- 2. Conference with students
- 3. Peace Corner
- 4. Take away student privilege
- 5. Phone call home parent/guardian
- 6. Time-out in another team members classroom (15 minutes)
- 7. Parent conference with teacher
- 8. Teacher will complete minor referral in Spotlight
- 9. Teacher will complete counselor referral form
- 10. Student, with documentation of behavior, will be sent to Behavior Interventionist for a reflection assignment
- 11. Conference with teacher, administrator, and MTSS facilitator to develop a behavior plan
- 12. Create a Major referral
- 13. If student is suspended, a re-entry conference will occur

Below is a motto for students to write as a reminder of daily expectations. The teacher can designate the number of times it should be written. This can be done when students are in time-out in another team members classroom or when a loss of privilege is given.
