# Team Expectations

- Attendance & Participation – All team members must be present, engaged, and contributing during each meeting.
- Season Schedule – Weekly meetings run from August 2025 to May 2026.
- Absences – More than three unexcused absences may result in probation or removal from the team.
- Team Fees – The \$100 team fee is due in two installments: \$50 by September 12, 2025 and \$50 by October 10, 2025.
- Code of Conduct – All Richmond County Student Code of Conduct rules apply at all times.
- Safety First – Follow all safety procedures in the build space, at events, and when operating tools or machinery. If you are ill, please stay home.

- Electronics Policy – Personal devices are allowed only for contacting guardians or FTC-related research. Other use is prohibited.
- Independent Learning – Team members may need to complete learning or practice outside of scheduled meetings.
- Academic Standards – Maintain an A/B average in all classes. Grades will be checked weekly; falling below this standard may result in probation or removal.
- Competitions – All competitions are held on Saturdays. Attendance is mandatory.
- Outreach – Participation in outreach activities outside regular meetings is required.
- Fundraising – All team members are expected to participate in fundraising efforts.

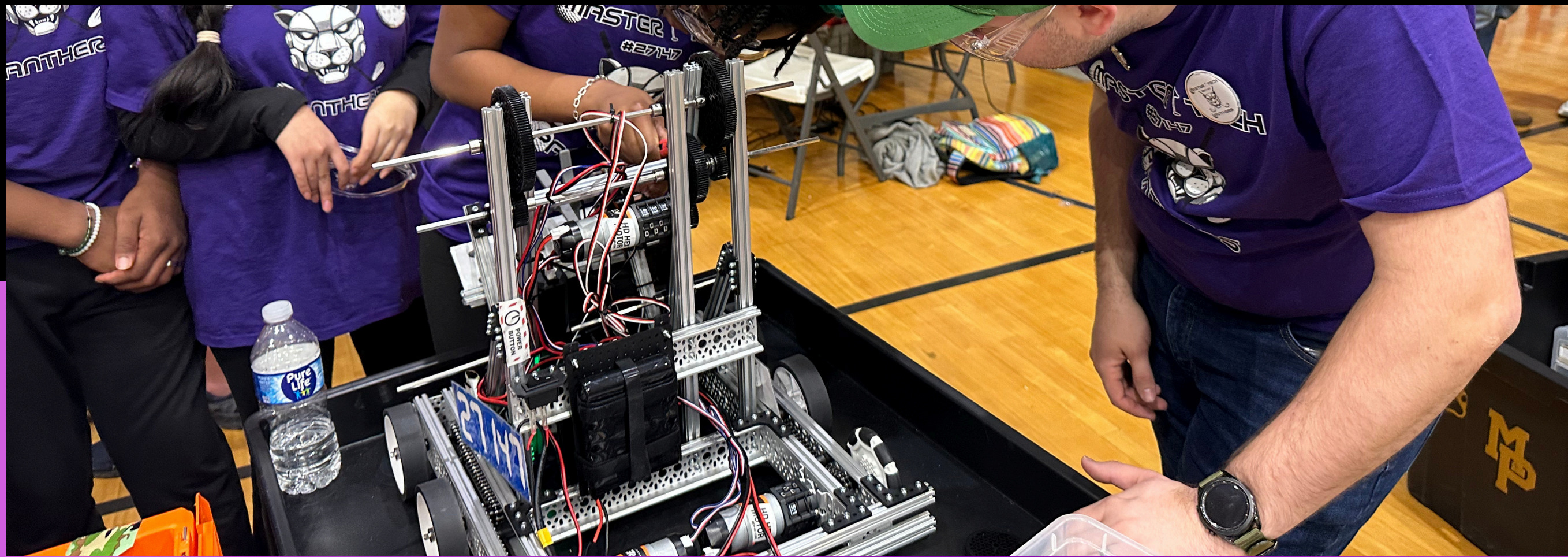

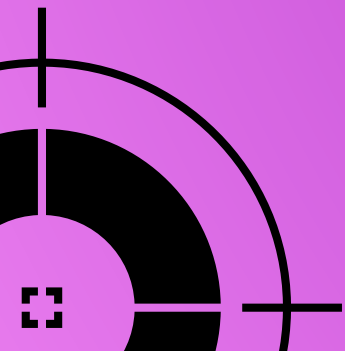
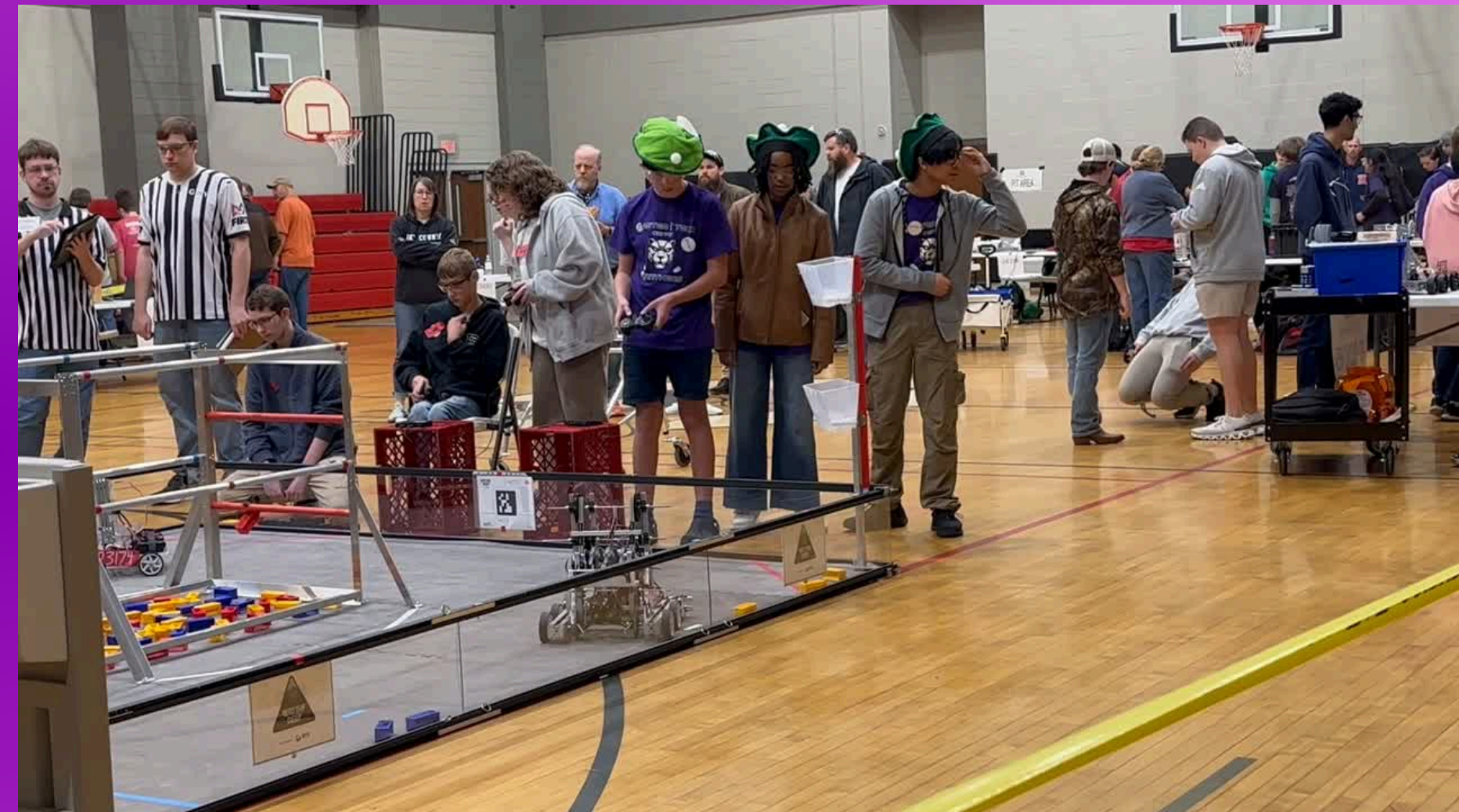
## Cost to Participate

**Affordable fees ensure every student can join our robotics team with enthusiasm.**

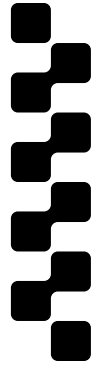
Our team has a small participation fee to cover essential materials and registration costs, promoting accessibility for all interested students.
