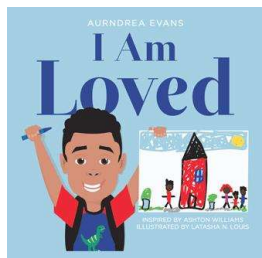

KEY VOCABULARY - **Possibilities**- having many different choices and options to choose from; **Smudge** - a dirty mark or smear; **Oops** - something we say when we make a mistake, sort of an apology to show we are sorry

- Ask if they remember someone saying "oops," or if they remember saying, "oops."
- What happened that made someone say, "oops?"
- How did you react after making a mistake?
