SENIOR CONTRACT – CLASS OF 2025

Eligibility requirements for ALL activities:

- 1. You must have senior status: To be considered a senior you need at least 18 credits.
- 2. You must be on track to graduate in May 2025: See your counselor for details or questions.
- 3. You must have passing grades in all classes
- 4. You must have met the minimum attendance requirements.
 - a. Your absences cannot exceed 10 unexcused absences
 - b. Excused absences are excluded from this total.
- 5. I understand that participation in senior activities is dependent upon my behavior. Major infractions can result in nonparticipation.

Major infractions include but are not limited to:

- -Any behavior that could result in suspension, expulsion, or the involvement of law enforcement
- -Possession of a dangerous weapon
- -Gang related activity
- -Disruptive behavior
- -Defacing or injuring school property
- -Harassment, bullying, cyber-bullying, hazing and retaliation
- 6. If you are assigned in-school or out-of-school suspension, you will not be allowed to participate in senior activities on those days.
