

## GOSA CCRPI Single Score Calculation

### Department of Accountability and Federal Programs Richmond County School System

Note: On January 22, 2025, the Governor's Office of Student Achievement released publicly the CCRPI single scores for the 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 school years. As you are aware, the Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE) added an amendment in the 2022 *Every Students Succeed Act* that did away with a single score and move to 4 CCRPI scored components for Elementary and Middle School, and 5 CCRPI scored components for High School. However, legislation and state law were passed this past year that required the Governors Office of Student Achievement (GOSA) to write methodology and release a single CCRPI score for each school and district. The Governors Office of Student Achievement are using pre-pandemic weights that the Georgia Department of Education used prior to the ESSA amendment. Those weights are below by CCRPI Component.

Example of Methodology and Calculations:

Elementary School	Content Mastery	Progress	Closing Gaps	Readiness
2024 State Score- Elementary	67.8	86.2	100	83.2

Content Mastery:  $67.8 \times 0.30 = 20.34$   
Progress:  $86.2 \times 0.35 = 30.17$   
Closing Gaps:  $100 \times 0.15 = 15.0$   
+ Readiness:  $83.2 \times 0.20 = 16.64$
