Course Description:

The purpose of this course is to help you stay current on your classes, make-up late or missing assignments, and to learn valuable tips to help become more successful in the classroom.

Success Criteria:

Make 3% gain within personal subject area on Edgenuity.

Complete Pretest with 80% or better within Edgenuity.

Score 70% or better on assignments, quizzes, unit tests, cumulative exams with Edgenuity.

Expectations:

Daily Preparedness

- a. This means that you MUST bring the following EVERYDAY to progress towards completion of assignments given from all other classes
