SHOW INTEREST

Showing genuine interest in what your child is reading is a simple form of encouragement for them.

Sit & Listen

Rather than just telling your child to go and read for a certain amount of time, take the opportunity to sit and listen to your child read.

ask questions

Ask your child questions and have conversation during and after reading. Doing so is a form of showing interest, allows them to create dialogue, and builds comprehension.

praise them!

Give praise at every opportunity! From sounding out a word correctly, to making connections, to completing a book, etc. Praise builds confidence that is invaluable!
