Accountable-

- Come to class prepared

- Respect each other's space.

Model-

- Respect bulletin boards and displays.
- Follow directions.
- Keep voice level at a 0.
- Walk to the right. (Right foot in the brown)

Accountable-

- Pick up all trash.
- Adhere to lunch line rules.
- Be respectful of classroom rules.

Integrity-

- Speak with an inside voice.
- Clean up your area.

Model-

- Remain seated during lunch period.
- Respect other's personal space and property.

- Report and issues to an adult.
- Return books on time.

INTEGRITY

ACCOUNTABLE-

- Be alert and aware of surroundings.
- Adhere to the rules of the tasks given.
- Be respectful of gym Rules.

INTEGRITY-

- Keep your hands, feet and all objects to yourself.
- Use gym equipment appropriately.

MODEL-

- Practice good sportsmanship.
- Treat others as you would like to be treated.
- Respect other's personal space and property.

SEMINOLE **BUS** EXPECTATIONS

Accountable-

- Remain seated.
- Keep hands, feet, and all other objects to yourself.
- Listen to the driver and follow directions.

Integrity-

- Resolve conflicts with maturity.
- Exit the bus at your assigned stop.
- Keep aisle clear.
- Keep volume at a level 3 or lower and use appropriate language.

Model-

- Enter and exit quietly.
- Keep food and drinks off the bus or inside your bookbag.
- Report any issues to the bus driver.

Student of the Month Criteria

1. Accountability of Attendance:

Has not missed any days of school this month.

2. Tolerance behavior towards others

- Always has a positive attitude
- Always self directs
- Always sets a positive example for others to follow
- Hardly ever disrespectful
- Works well with staff and peers

3. Safety at all times

- Always sits in his/her assigned seats
- Always uses words not actions to express emotions.
- Always waits quietly for his/her turn.
- Always ignores inappropriate behavior

4. Respectful

- Always responsible
- Always acknowledges his own role in a situation
- Always respects the privacy of others
