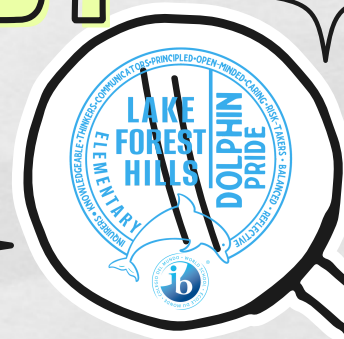

GRIT is an important attribute/skill for a student's future success and can be defined in several ways. GRIT means the following: passion required for long term success, perseverance, resilience, and a tenacious attitude toward reaching goals. Those with GRIT are able to show a determination to overcoming obstacles and keep going regardless of setbacks and roadblocks.

Mrs. Hooper has been using bibliotherapy in her lessons to foster this important characteristic in our students and help make real-life connections.

Grit is a critical predictor of adult success; in fact, most researchers believe that having GRIT is more important than raw talent and or academic prowess.
