This year instructional time should focus on four critical areas: (1) developing understanding of and applying proportional relationships; (2) developing understanding of operations with rational numbers and working with expressions and linear equations; (3) solving problems involving scale drawings and informal geometric constructions, and working with two and three-dimensional shapes to solve problems involving area, surface area, and volume, and (4) drawing inferences about populations based on samples.

In addition to the content standards, we will be focusing throughout the year on the Standards for Mathematical Practice. These standards describe the way we think about math and what we can do to become better mathematicians. You will hear about them during the year. We will be using the 7th grade edition of Houghton Mifflin Harcourt Middle School Go Math.
